The Florence Crittenton Campus' expanded Early Childhood Education (ECE) Center promotes physical, cognitive and social-emotional development for children beginning at six weeks old. ECE Center staff cooperate with a number of community partners to facilitate trauma-informed training to teen mothers, teachers, and staff, one-on-one play therapy, and provide early childhood care and intervention services. Through its multi-faceted sustainability model, Florence Crittenton Services' is unique in its ability to provide children of teen mothers with high quality care not found elsewhere in the community. The new center has an additional three classrooms (a total of ten), for the first time allowing children older than three to continue their education on campus through Pre-K. This expansion will allow more teen mothers access to academic services at Florence Crittenton High School while their children become kindergarten-ready.



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
