After enrolling at Florence Crittenton High School, Alyssa found herself surrounded by teachers, classmates, and staff who understood the unique challenges of being a teen mom and a student. She felt like she finally belonged.

This program not only boosted her confidence but also showed her that she is more than just a "teen mom." With support from FloCrit, Alyssa transformed from feeling embarrassed about her situation to owning her identity. Florence Crittenton gave her all the support she needed to handle both being a teenager and a mom. Alyssa graduated in May 2023 and is now studying Criminal Justice at the Community College of Aurora.
