Early Childhood Education Center

Providing high quality education for children of teen moms ages 6 weeks to 5 years old:

- 10 classrooms for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers
 - Highly trained teachers
- Family-style meals promoting healthy eating habits
 - Breastfeeding support
 - Lunchtime family engagement events
- Free book lending program for teen moms and children
- Home visiting through Early Head Start programs
- ITERS rating scale in the preschool classroom with Colorado Shines
 - Creative Curriculum facilitated by teachers to support the Objectives for Development as outlined by My Teaching Strategies (GOLD)
 - Classroom environments structured to meet the highest standards on the Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale (ECERS)
 - Support accessing early intervention services as needed through Child Find
 - Child Development Classes

Transportation
